



## Questions to ask your Doctor About Immunotherapy

You may wish to print this page and take it with you to your next doctor visit as a reminder of important questions to ask about immunotherapy. This list is derived from our “How to talk to your Doctor About Immunotherapy” document.

- What parts of the immune system are involved in my immunotherapy treatment? How do they normally function and what is their role?
- What part of the immune system will my immunotherapy work on?
- How will my immunotherapy work to combat my disease?
- Is my immunotherapy passive or active? What does this mean/why is this important?
- What will be the delivery method for my treatment? What are the consequences of this in terms of side effects?
- What kinds of side effects can I expect from this treatment? How can I minimize them?
- Will this treatment interact with any other treatments I am receiving?
- **Remember to remind your doctor of any medications you are taking**
- How will I be able to tell if my immunotherapy is working?
- How long should I expect to wait before I see results or negative side effects?
- What is our next step if this therapy doesn't work or produces unexpected negative effects?
